I live deeper in the ocean than any other fish.

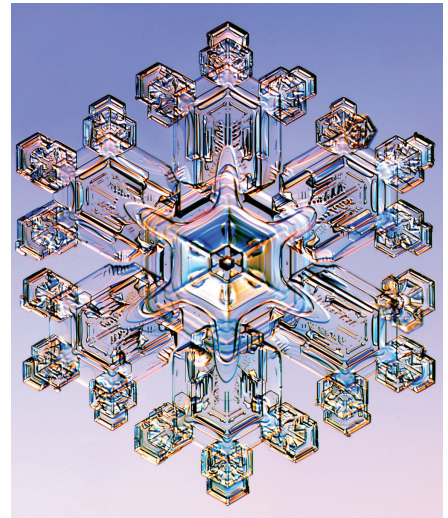
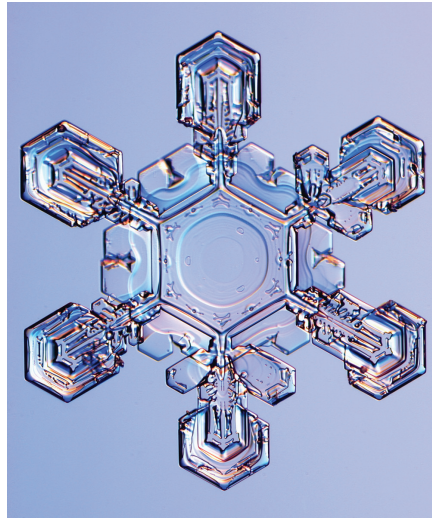
Tarantula and Tarantula Hawk Wasp WHY IS IT LIKE THAT?

WHY IS IT LIKE THAT?

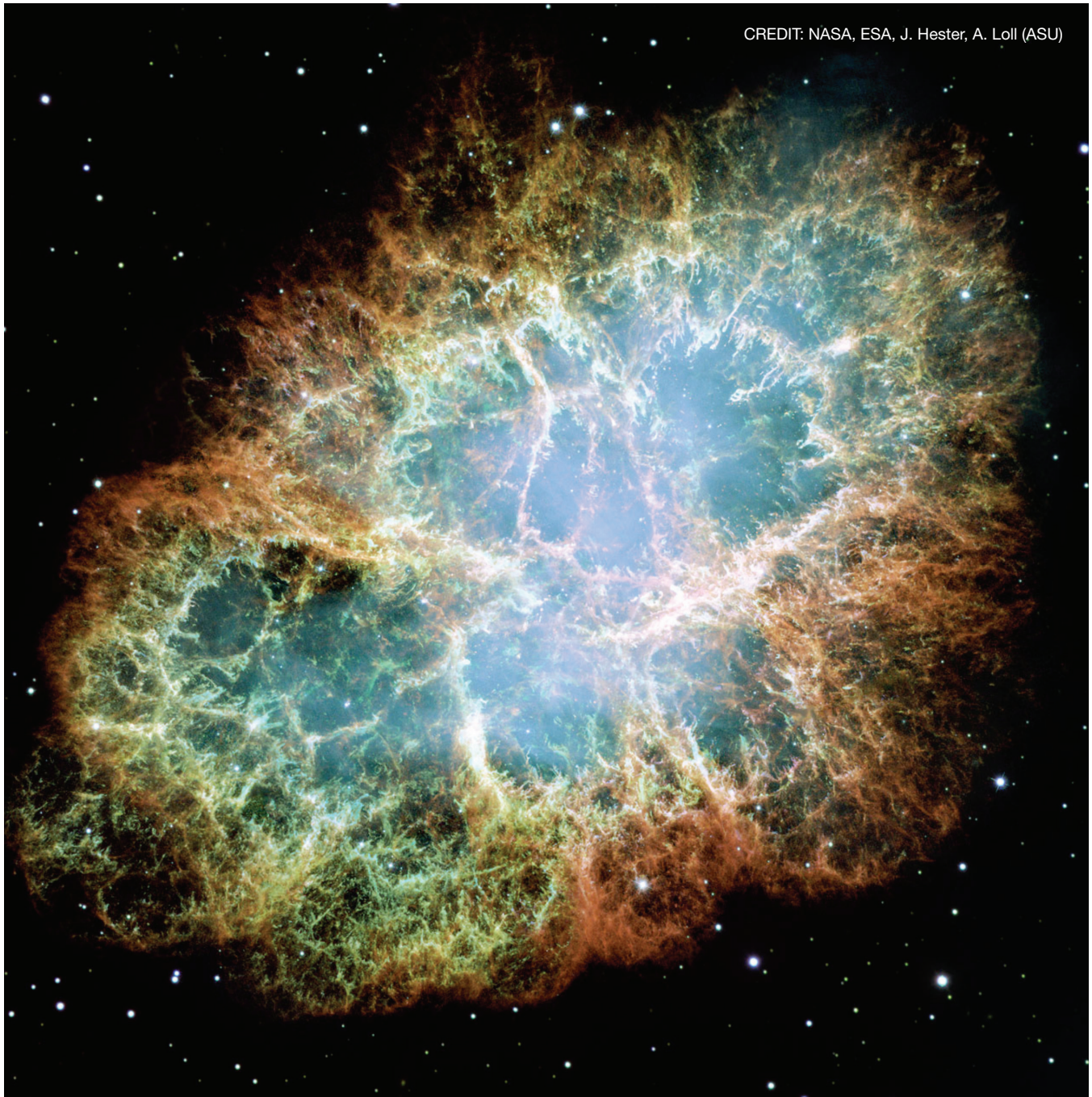
